LICENSING ACT 2003

Licensable activities – to be read in conjunction with the Standard Conditions of Hire.

The purpose of the system of licensing for licensable activities, especially the sale/supply of alcohol, is to promote 4 fundamental objectives:

- (a) the prevention of crime and disorder;
- (b) public safety;
- (c) the prevention of public nuisance, and
- (d) the protection of children from harm.

The Committee will, as managers of the premises, endeavour to provide premises which are safe for public use.

Appleshaw Village Hall Management Committee ('the Committee') requires all Hirers holding licensable activities to comply with the Conditions of Hire as displayed on the Booking Form, including safety points.

The Hirer undertakes that:

- activities extending beyond the licensing hours will not be permitted.
Licensing hours are:
 - 1100 hours to 2300 hours Sunday to Thursday
 - 1100 hours to 2345 hours Friday and Saturday
 - 1100 hours New Year's Eve to 0001 hours New Year's Day
- he/she will endeavour to ensure that those leaving the premises at night do so quietly;
- no illegal drugs will be brought on to the premises.
- Films: no children who are below the age classification for the film(s) on show will be admitted;
- no gambling or entertainment of an adult nature will be permitted;
- adult supervisors will be provided at a rate of at least one per 20 children who are under 16 (or part thereof). Government guidelines on this subject are complicated and for ease of application this ratio is based on the requirements for the youngest age group.
